



MATTRESS SIZES AND QUILT MEASURES

(Note: For crib quilt, we suggest a size similar to the mattress size. Also, keep in mind that mattress heights, as well as box springs, can vary from 3 to 20 inches. We recommend you inspect your bed before deciding on your quilt size.)

To figure an alternate size:

- 1.) Verify actual size of your mattress.
- 2.) Determine desired drop from one side or bottom of the bed.
- 3.) Determine size of pillow tuck, if desired.
- 4.) Multiply your desired drop by two, and add this number to your mattress length; if a pillow tuck is desired, add that amount to this number. This number is the length of your quilt.
- 5.) Add the desired drop to the width of your mattress. This number is the width of your quilt.
