

**FINISHED SIZE:**  
50" X 50"

**ADDITIONAL FABRIC NEEDED:**

- 1/8 yard of red for Log Cabin center
- Light prints for Log Cabin Blocks: 7/8 yd
- Dark prints for Log Cabin Blocks: 7/8yd
- 1 yd Beige for additional borders
- Red print for binding: 1/2 yard

**FOR ADDITIONAL BLOCKS, CUT:**

- (24) 1 1/2" squares of red for small Log Cabin centers
- Light prints for small Log Cabin Blocks: a variety of 1" strips
- Dark prints for Log Cabin Blocks: a variety of 1" strips
- Additional Beige borders: (2) 3" x 25 1/2"; (2) 3" x 30 1/2"; (2) 2 1/2 x 42 1/2"; (2) 2 1/2" x 50 1/2"
- (5) 2" strips from binding fabric.

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## Jack's House Renovation (2)

### THE SITUATION

One of our app users purchased the Primitive Quilts and Projects (Summer 2014,) and loves "The House That Jack Built" Designed by Debbie Wick. The pattern makes a quilt that finishes 25" x 25," but our quilter needs it to be 50" x 50". So, we're making some suggestions as to how this quilt can be made bigger.

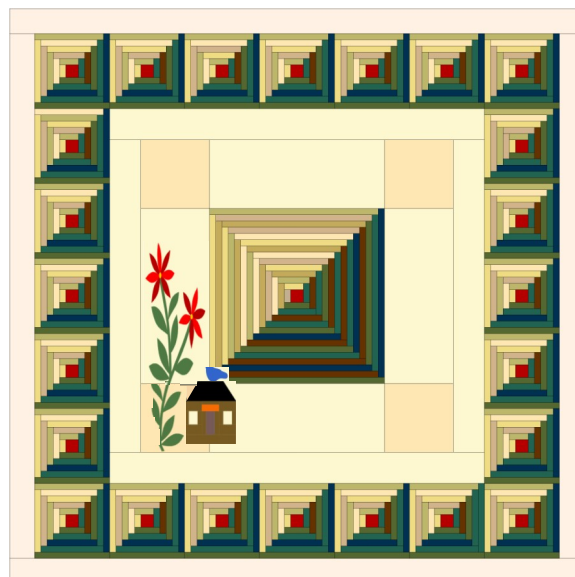
Our second suggestion is to construct the center as directed, then add a row of log cabin blocks to the outside. To construct, use the original directions to construct the quilt base, then follow these:

### CONSTRUCT ADDITIONAL BLOCKS

Using original directions, construct (14) log cabin blocks measuring 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".

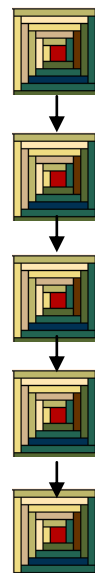
### ADD FIRST NEW BORDER

Sew (1) 3" x 25 1/2" border to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) 3" x 30 1/2" border to the top and to the bottom of quilt center.

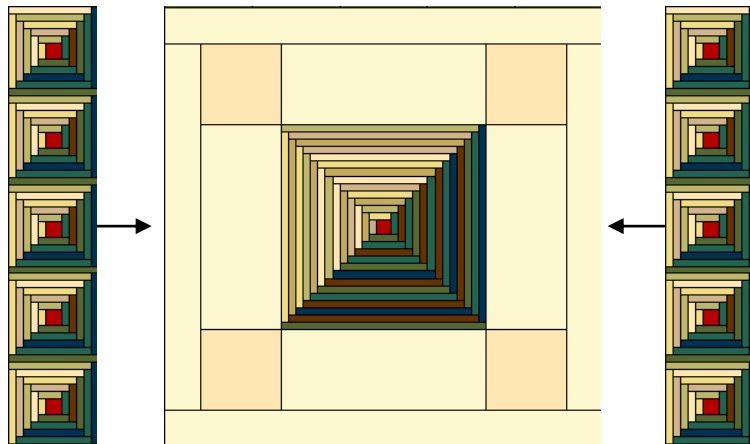


### ADD LOG CABIN BORDER

Sew (5) log cabin blocks together to form a border as shown. Repeat to make (2) total.

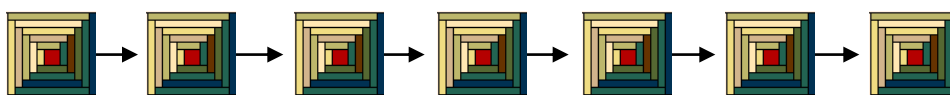


Sew one of these borders to each side of the quilt.

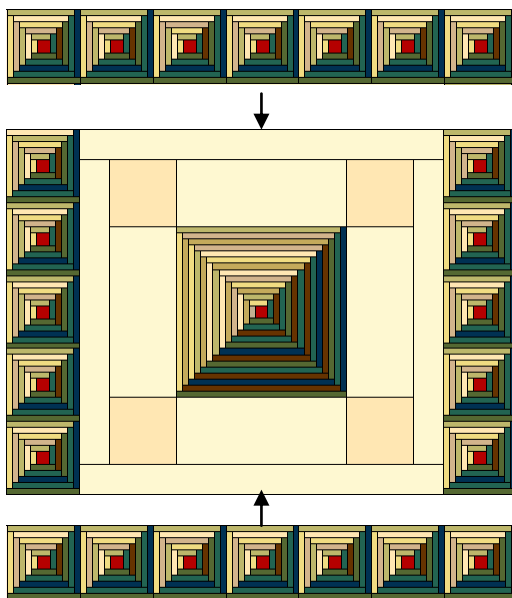


*This is a great quilt to use to practice sewing the quarter inch seam. Check our app if you're not sure you've found your "true" quarter inch seam.*

Sew (7) small log cabin blocks together to form a border as shown. Repeat to make (2) total.



Sew one of these borders to the top of the quilt and one to the bottom of the quilt.



### ADD NEW OUTSIDE BORDER

Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" border to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 50 1/2" border to the top and to the bottom of quilt center.

### FINISH

Appliqué, layer, quilt and bind according to original instructions.
